Manhattan Associates delivers hands-on customer training with Skytap Virtual IT Labs

Background

For holding in-person customer training sessions, Manhattan Associates needed a virtual labs solution that would make setup and configuration simple for instructors and provide customers with an effective training environment for learning how to use their software.

Challenge

Manhattan Associates offers comprehensive training courses for customers to learn how to use its supply chain management software and stay up-to-date with the latest features. Prior to Skytap, instructors had to transport 25 laptops and duplicated hard drives to onsite training sessions, which was logistically challenging and required heavy lifting. After each training session and before using laptops for a different customer, the laptops had to be manually refreshed by unscrewing hard drives and replacing them with new ones. This process could take up to two hours and often was conducted at the airport when an instructor was en route to a new training site.

The company also conducts training internally for both new hires and third-party resellers using the same laptops and hardware. Because there were only so many laptops available and customer training took precedence, other training at times had to be delayed or team members had to share laptops.

The ability to customize each environment on the fly provides a stronger training experience for the learner and ensures they are fully prepared to use the software in practice.
